The Organization

The Job

The Bilingual Youth Engagement Coordinator will coordinate and oversee all youth engagement efforts for middle and high school students. This person will be the point of contact for mentors, students, and the families of participating students. Specifically, this individual will:

- Report to the Family Engagement Director and the Executive Director;
- Provide support to and work collaboratively with the Family Engagement Director and the Bilingual Outreach & Family Engagement Coordinator;
- Provide support to and supervise relevant interns and part-time staff;
- Coordinate and facilitate Youth Engagement Programming, including but not limited to:
 - The Youth Council and Youth Council Advisory Board (YCAB)
 - Plan and facilitate 2-3 meetings per month
 - Conduct outreach to prospective members
 - Assist with annual elections for YCAB
 - The Mentorship Program
 - Organize, plan, and facilitate open houses/orientations/other relevant activities
 - Recruit mentors and mentees, review applications, and pair matches
 - Conduct check-ins and evaluations
 - General Youth Engagement activities
 - Plan/coordinate/facilitate meetings, workshops, and field trips



- Conduct on-going outreach, including one-on-one sessions with youth and/or their families as needed
- Represent Providence Promise at community events and activities;
- Attend relevant training sessions when applicable

The Ideal Candidate will:

- Have a Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field.
- Be fluent in both English and Spanish.
- Be knowledgeable about challenges faced by many families in Providence and how to connect families with helpful resources.
- Be comfortable with public speaking and interaction.
- Have a commitment to the education of public school children.
- Be available to work a varied & flexible schedule (including occasional evenings and Saturday's).
- Be a problem-solver who can identify the problem and determine the solution.
- Be reliable, punctual, and well-organized.
- Be confident in working with diverse groups and with peers.
- Have excellent written; computer and verbal communication skills.
- Have the ability to work independently but seek support and direction if necessary.
